



ALGEBRA 1 REQUIRED MATERIALS

2016-2017

- A **MATH ONLY 2"** THREE RING BINDER along with 3 dividers for:
"Notes", "Homework", and "Tests/Quizzes". (NO TRAPPER KEEPERS!)
- PAPER:
 - Notebook filler paper, college ruled, $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 11"$, 3-hole punched
 - Graph paper, $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 11"$, 3-hole punched
- HOLE REINFORCEMENTS
- STUDENT AGENDA: for writing down assignments
- PENCILS: (# 2 lead Pencils) Pencils are an obvious algebra necessity. However, at this point in math you will be required to make precise lines to show where lines intersect or where points are located on a graph. Therefore you will need to keep your pencils sharp all the time or use mechanical pencils. (HINT: Buy 0.5 mm lead mechanical pencils and lead. The line is sharper and the lead is easier to replace later. It's best to avoid 0.7 mm altogether.)
- A GOOD ERASER: A good eraser makes your work neat and easier to understand. (My favorite is STAEDTLER Mars Plastic eraser which is usually found in the drafting section of most office supply stores. It's awesome!)
- (1) SMALL STRAIGHT-EDGE: 6 inch ruler, small protractor, etc. to draw nice, straight lines.
- (2) GLUE STICKS
- COLORED PENCILS
- (1) LOW ODOR DRY ERASE MARKER (black or blue)
- (1) RED PEN for correcting homework
- (2) YELLOW HIGHLIGHTERS
- (1) small PAIR OF SCISSORS
