



Mrs. Sepe's Overview of the ISN

What is an ISN?

You are a mathematician. Mathematicians use notebooks and journals to record data, illustrations, charts, graphs, and their thinking. You can also use it to record your questions and ideas. Interactive Notebooks are like a personalized textbook that **YOU** create!

They help you to keep your notes organized and easy to access. They also act as a portfolio to showcase everything you've learned in math class. Your Math notebook will be used very frequently, so make sure it is in class **EVERY** day. If you do not have your notebook, take notes on a separate piece of paper and then transfer the notes in your notebook. We will follow guidelines when using our notebooks to make then informative and interesting. Your notebook should reflect *your* experiences, *your* thinking and *your* creativity, but it should also be easily understood by others.



What's the Point?

The purpose of the IN is to help you learn and remember important mathematical concepts. The interactive part is the use of the LEFT side of the Notebook to react, reflect, organize and interpret what is on the **RIGHT** side!

How Does an IN Work?

The IN is set up with a left-side/right-side orientation. The right side is for **input**, or information that is given to you by Mrs. Sepe, such as class notes, vocabulary, handouts, graphic organizers, etc. The left side is for **output**, this is where you process what you have learned, such as homework assignments, reflections, exit ticket problems, or higher order thinking questions.

What supplies to I need?

To make your IN, you'll need the following materials listed below. We will be setting up our interactive notebooks during the first week of school.

- Marble Composition pad (college ruled)
- At least 3 Pencils
- 1 red pen
- Erasers
- Glue sticks/tape
- Colored pencils
- Highlighters
- 1 pair of small scissors

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How will I be graded?

You should have all items (assignments, class work, notes, etc.) that the Table of Contents has listed even for the days when you were absent. You will have periodic (weekly or biweekly) "IN" Checks" and your notebook will be collected at the end of each marking period and scored based on the rubric provided. A significant part of your final grade is based on the notebook!

What happens if I am absent?

If you are absent, it is your responsibility to collect the missing handouts, etc. from the 'While you were out" station in my classroom. You should also check in with a trusted friend to copy any notes. Make sure to put items on the correct pages and record assignments in the table of contents. There is a teacher copy of the IN available for you to check with if you are unsure of how yours should look.

What if I lose my Interactive Notebook?

Let me know right away!

Do not quit working on assignments! You can always tape /attach papers inside your notebook if it is found afterward. Since a portion of your final grade for this class is based on your interactive notebook, your grade will suffer if you do not make up the work. You are welcome to stay after school or during lunch to rebuild the IN with my help.
