






Sources of Revenue 2015-16

Tax Impact of Proposed Budget

- ▶ The increase in the General Fund tax levy is 1.1% and the increase in the Debt Service tax levy is 18.42%
- ▶ Combining the General Fund and Debt Service tax levies results in an overall increase of 2.16%
- ▶ The total assessed valuation of Long Hill Township decreased last year by (-0.23%)
- ▶ The proposed tax rate per \$100,000 of assessed valuation is \$1.232, up 2.39% from the current year


