Teacher Requests

The following teacher requests will be voted on:

Eileen Shanagher, music teacher at Millington School is requesting \$500 for 2 snare drums for the 5th grade band. The 2 snare drums would be used for 7 drummers and will replace a very old piece of equipment.

Danielle Bauer, Gillette School, is requesting \$1,930 for a laminator to be used on printed books to help them last longer.

Joelle Varner, music teacher at Central Middle School, is requesting \$3,687.99 for a new Tuba in order to have a properly working instrument to be used to help student players be successful and strengthen the foundation of the entire ensemble.

Patricia Paugh, librarian at Central Middle School, is requesting \$3,957.34 for books of various titles to update the library collection and support the 40 book challenge and provide copies of books used in literature circles in the classroom.
