Teacher Requests

The following teacher requests will be voted on:

Dr. Jones, Principal, Gillette School, is requesting \$9,795 plus shipping/handling for a new playground slide climber to replace the 2 horse rockers at Gillette School playground.

Melissa Backer, Dean of Students, is requesting \$650 to buy the rights to show the documentary "Screenagers." Ms. Backers elaborated on the program, which covers social media, video games, internet use and how to navigate through a digital world. There will be 2-3 viewings, one being in the evening so parents may attend.

Jane Fragnito, 5th grade teacher, Millington School, is requesting \$265 for 25 copies of *Number the Stars* to be used for class novel study.

Jane Fragnito, 5th grade teacher, Millington School, is requesting \$318.50 for 25 copies of *Bridge to Terabithia* to be used for class novel study.
