# LONG HILL TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING NOVEMBER 28, 2011

The Long Hill Township Board of Education held a Regular Monthly Meeting on Monday, November 28, 2011 in the Long Hill Township Town Hall. The meeting was called to order by Board President Lisa Scanlon at 7:30 p.m.

#### COMMUNICATIONS

## BOARD COMMITTEE REPORTS

Finance – Mr. Blocker reported the committee reviewed the bills and found all in order for payment. He also stated that there was a slight change in the dollar amount for the bills list for November 28, 2011. Mr. Blocker noted that Mr. Esposito met with the Finance Committee prior to the meeting and provided an overview of the 2012-2013 budget development process.

WHRHS Liaison – Mrs. Nyquist attended a Watchung Hills High School Board Meeting and discussed the changes made to their calendar as a result of the recent storms. They are in school on January 2 and February 16, 2011 but open on Martin Luther King Day (January 16). Mrs. Nyquist also discussed a bullying issue at the high school that was discussed at their meeting.

Community Relations – Mrs. Nyquist attended several bullying seminars and discussed some of the topics at a committee meeting held earlier today. She talked about the possibility of doing a "bullet" highlight of our Board Meeting; she will talk to Dr. Rovtar about it. Mrs. Nyquist also stated that Ms. Barone is following legislative changes and they hope to pass the information on. Mrs. Nyquist is working on getting the STAR ribbon cutting ceremony in the newspaper.

Policy – Mr. Carbone asked that the word "adopt" be changed to "approve" on the resolution regarding policies.

#### SUPERINTENDENT'S UPDATE

Dr. Rovtar said the Piano Lab Open House is tomorrow night and all are invited. She attended a local OEM meeting tonight to discuss recent responses to storms. Discussion included reviewing communication lines and an ability to get information out via phone lines, cell phones and texts. Dr. Rovtar stated we will work with the town to try to improve this situation.

## **BOARD SECRETARY'S UPDATE**

Mr. Esposito stated that a presentation on the audit will be done by Mr. Colantano at the December 12 meeting. Mr. Esposito also indicated that he has spoken with the Bond Counsel with regard to the refinancing of the 2004 bond issue. The district might realize significant savings over the life of the bonds if they can be refinanced at a lower interest rate.
