# LONG HILL TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING SEPTEMBER 26, 2011

The Long Hill Township Board of Education held a Regular Monthly Meeting on Monday, September 26, 2011 in the Long Hill Township Town Hall. The meeting was called to order by Board President Lisa Scanlon.

## BOARD COMMITTEE REPORTS

Finance – Mr. Blocker reported the committee reviewed the bills and found all in order for payment. The committee also discussed resolution #3 and is supportive of the administration's recommendation regarding the deposit of surplus funds into Capital Reserve and Maintenance Reserve.

Policy – Mr. Carbone stated the committee will meet on October 3.

Watchung Hills Regional High School Liaison – Mr. Carbone and Mrs. Nyquist have each selected 6 meetings to attend.

# SUPERINTENDENT'S UPDATE

Dr. Rovtar reported that the Shared Services Steering Committee, comprised of the superintendents and business administrators from all of the regional school districts, had its first meeting of the year. The topics discussed included 1) a discussion of the legal definition of shared services according to the State, 2) a discussion of Power Purchase Agreements for solar energy and what each district is doing in that regard, 3) an update on the technology initiatives being implemented and considered by each district for the future, 4) possible areas for joint purchasing and bidding that might be incorporated into the development of the 2012-2013 budgets, and 5) implementation of the anti-bullying bill of rights act in each district. The focus of the October meeting will be on budget development issues.

The 3 schools have concluded their Back to School Nights and all were very well attended

The fall is state reporting season and the central office staff has worked very hard over the summer to implement the new personnel management system that will allow us to generate the data needed for some of these state reports.

### **BOARD SECRETARY'S UPDATE**

Mr. Esposito provided each Board Member with information from New Jersey School Boards Association on the required Board Member training.

Mr. Esposito also reported that the auditor was in for a week to complete the field work for the audit. There will be no recommendations in the year's audit report. Mr. Colantano will come to a Board meeting in November or December to make a presentation on the audit report when it has been finalized. The Finance Committee discussed the surplus funds being deposited into the reserve accounts to be used to offset future expenses.

APPROVAL OF TRANSFER OF SURPLUS FUNDS

WHEREAS, NJSA 18A:21-2 and NJSA 18A:7G-13 permit a Board of Education to establish and/or deposit into certain reserve accounts at year end, and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned statutes authorize procedures, under the authority of the Commissioner of Education, which permit a board of education to transfer anticipated express current revenue or unexpended appropriations into reserve accounts during the month of June by board resolution, and

WHEREAS, the Long Hill Township Board of Education wishes to deposit anticipated current year surplus into a Capital Reserve account (\$650,000) and Maintenance Reserve account (\$244,572) at year end, and

WHEREAS, the Long Hill Township Board of Education has determined that up to \$994,572 is available for such purpose of transfer,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Long Hill Township Board of Education that it hereby authorizes the district's School Business Administrator to make this transfer consistent with all applicable laws and regulations.

RESOLVED that the Long Hill Township Board of Education, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6:20-2.13(E), certifies that as of July 31, 2011 after review of the Board Secretary's monthly financial report (appropriations section) and upon consultation with appropriate district officials, to the best of our knowledge, no major account or fund has been overexpended in violation of N.J.A.C. 6:20-2.13(B), and sufficient funds are available to meet the district's financial obligations for the remainder of the year.
