2. RESOLVED, that the Long Hill Township School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey approves the 2012-13 school district budget for submission as follows:

 General Fund
 \$15,123,936.00

 Special Revenue Fund
 \$ 313,617.00

 Debt Service Fund
 \$ 1,244,143.00

 Total Budget 2012-13
 \$16,681,696.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there should be raised for the General Fund \$13,841,574.00 and for Debt Service \$1,244,143.00 for the ensuing School Year 2012-13; and

WHEREAS, the district has a taxing authority which is composed of \$0.00 for health benefits adjustment and \$0.00 for enrollment adjustment and \$0.00 for PERS Deferment are available to the district for the school budget for 2012-13.

The 2% cap increase over the prior year, which totals \$277,476.00, results in a maximum district general fund tax levy of \$14,151,297.00. The proposed negative tax levy for 2012-2013 generates an additional \$32,247.00 in unused taxing authority, resulting in a total banked cap amount of \$309,723.00 for the district.

WHEREAS, The Board has approved that there should be raised for the General Fund a tax levy of \$13,841,574.00 for the ensuing School Year (2012-2013).

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Long Hill Township School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey approves that the unused taxing authority of \$309,723.00 be banked for potential use in the subsequent three fiscal years.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Long Hill Township School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey approves the withdrawal of \$250,000.00 from the Capital Reserve to provide funding for the following Projects:

- District-wide replacement and repair of aging, leaking roofs (including professional fees, bidding costs, etc.): \$150,000
- Development and installation of district-wide energy management system (including professional fees, bidding costs, etc.): \$100,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Long Hill Township School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey approves the following capital projects for the 2012-2013 school year:

- Assessment on prior referendum projects (State mandatory deduction): \$33,181
- District-wide replacement and repair of aging, leaking roofs (including professional fees, bidding costs, etc.): \$150,000
- Development and installation of district-wide energy management system (including professional fees, bidding costs, etc.): \$100,000

WHEREAS, school district policy and N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3(a) provides that the board of education shall establish in the annual school budget a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for such travel and expense reimbursement for the 2012-2013 school year; and

WHEREAS, maximum expenditure amount allotted for travel and expense reimbursement for the 2011-2012 school year was \$30,000.00; and

WHEREAS, travel and expense reimbursement has reached a total amount \$16,000.00 as of March 1, 2012;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Long Hill Township School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for the 2012-2013 school year at the sum of \$30.000.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to insure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A:5.2 (a) mandates boards to establish annually prior to budget preparation, for public relations and each type of professional service a maximum level of spending for the ensuring school year; and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget includes the following appropriations

WHEREAS, the Administration needs to notify the board if there arises a need to exceed said maximums, upon which the board may adopt a dollar increase in the maximum amount through formal board action; and

WHEREAS, the Board and Administration wishes to minimize the amount of paperwork involved in this area;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Long Hill Township School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey establishes maximums for professional services in the areas listed above at a level of 120% of the amounts listed for the 2011-2012 school year.

It is duly noted that this budget represents an increase of 3.49% in general fund appropriations and a 0.23% <u>decrease</u> in the general fund tax levy.
