COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

At this point, the Board of Education welcomes comments from any member of the public. Please note that as per Board Policy #1120, a total of fifteen (15) minutes is allocated for public comments at any single Board meeting. In order to provide residents the opportunity to comment, individual speakers are limited to three minutes each at any particular Board meeting. The Board may extend these time limits at its discretion.

ADOPTION OF THE 2017-2018 BUDGET

RESOLVED, that the Long Hill Township School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey approves the 2017-18 school district budget as follows:

Total Budget 2017-18	\$17,327,867
Debt Service Fund 40	\$1,100,638
Special Revenue Fund 20	\$248,471
General Funds 10, 11, 12	\$15,978,758

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there should be raised for the General Fund **\$14,942,669.00** and for Debt Service **\$1,100,638.00** for the ensuing School Year 2017-18; and

The 2.0% cap increase over the prior year, which totals **\$292,993.00**, results in a maximum district general fund tax levy of **\$14,942,669.00**.

WHEREAS, The Board has approved that there should be raised for the General Fund a tax levy of **\$14,942,669.00** for the ensuing School Year (2017-2018).

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Long Hill Township School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey approves that the unused taxing authority of **\$47,746.00** be banked for potential use in the subsequent three fiscal years. The district has a total banked cap of **\$285,963.00** for use in 2017-2018.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Long Hill Township School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey approves the following capital projects for the 2017-2018 school year:

• Assessment on prior referendum projects (State mandatory deduction): \$33,181

WHEREAS, school district policy and N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3(a) provides that the board of education shall establish in the annual school budget a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for such travel and expense reimbursement for the 2017-2018 school year; and

WHEREAS, maximum expenditure amount allotted for travel and expense reimbursement for the 2016-2017 school year was **\$30,000.00**; and

WHEREAS, travel and expense reimbursement has reached a total amount **\$14,550.00** as of April 1, 2017;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Long Hill Township School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for the 2017-2018 school year at the sum of **\$30,000.00**; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to insure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A:5.2 (a) mandates boards to establish annually prior to budget preparation, for public relations and each type of professional service a maximum level of spending for the ensuring school year; and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget includes the following appropriations:

Legal Services	\$ 40,000.00
Accounting	\$ 25,000.00
Other Administrative Services	\$ 25,000.00
Repair Services	\$ 306,807.00
Extraordinary Services	\$ 98,400.00
Nonpublic Services	\$ 40,441.00
Professional Development	\$ 39,000.00
Transportation	\$ 911,539.00; and

WHEREAS, the Administration needs to notify the board if there arises a need to exceed said maximums, upon which the board may adopt a dollar increase in the maximum amount through formal board action; and

WHEREAS, the Board and Administration wishes to minimize the amount of paperwork involved in this area;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Long Hill Township School District Board of Education, in the County of Morris, New Jersey establishes maximums for professional services in the areas listed above at a level of 120% of the amounts listed for the 2017-2018 school year.

It is duly noted that this budget represents an increase of **1.99%** in general fund current appropriations and a **2.00%** increase in the general fund tax levy.
