# Background

Full 1:1 implementation expected by 2017-2018

In 2015-2016, all teachers received Chromebooks and Google Apps training

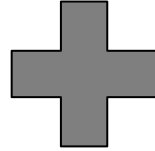
Summer 2016 - the Wireless Infrastructure was upgraded

Google Apps for Education



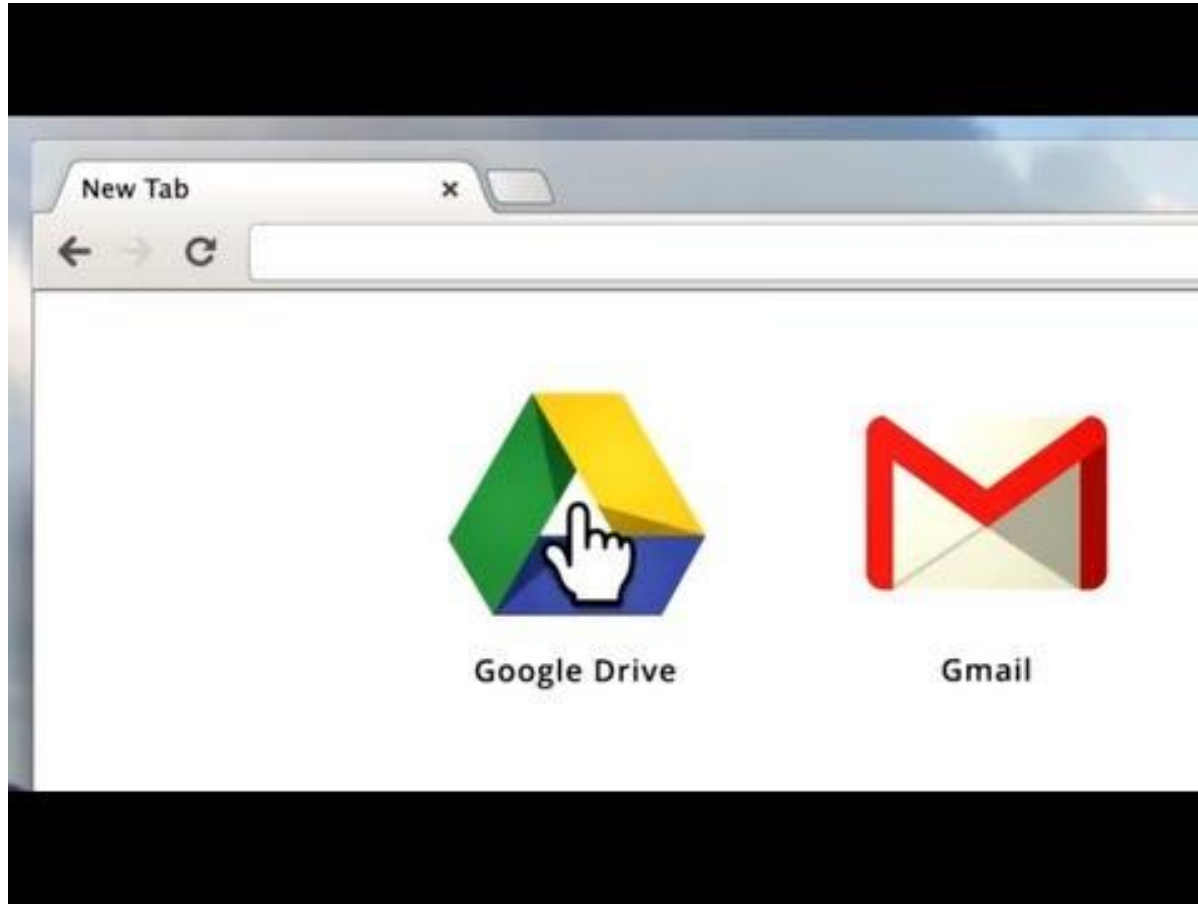
Students have a Google Mail account so that they can access the Google Drive but the mail feature is not activated.

# 2016-2017: 5th Grade 1:1 Pilot

Fifth grade students at Millington are piloting the Chromebook 1:1 implementation

- ◆ Every 5th grade student will receive a Chromebook and a case
- ◆ Students will be able to use it as directed for instruction by their teachers during the school day
- ◆ Students will be able use Google apps and digital resources, and collaborate with their classmates even at home
- ◆ Students should charge the Chromebook at home every night and bring it back to school the next day

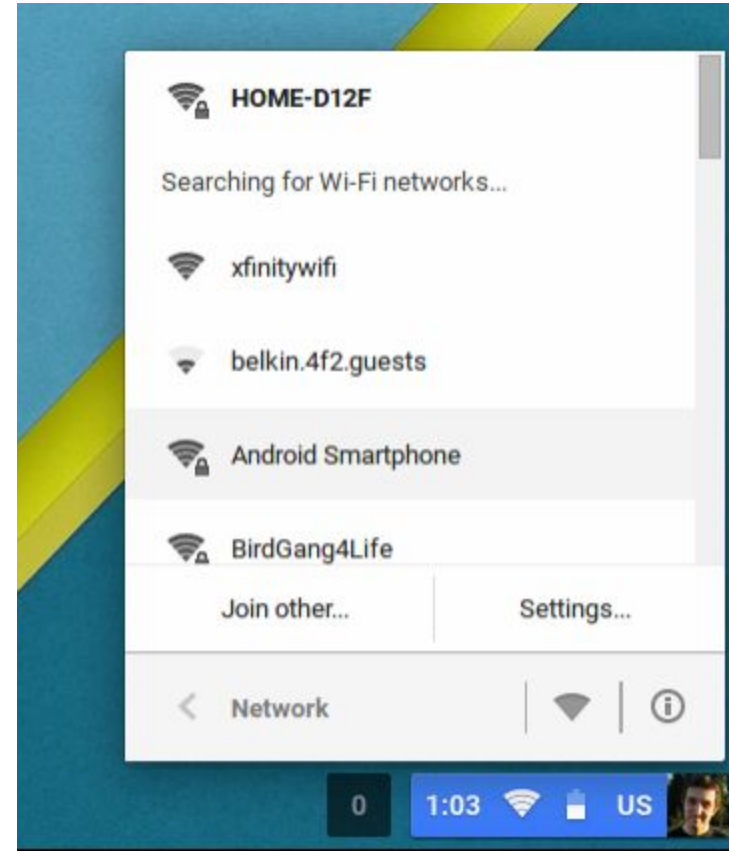
# What is Google Drive?



# Wifi Settings

At School, students will automatically connect to the district wifi. The district Internet filter is in effect

At home, students simply click on the internet connection icon on lower right of screen, choose the correct wi-fi signal, and enter password. The district Internet filter is not in effect



# Student Expectations

- ◆ Treat the Chromebook with care.
- ◆ Will not attempt to remove or change the physical structure of the Chromebook, including the keys, screen, cover or plastic casing.
- ◆ Will not add stickers or deface the unit in any way.
- ◆ Keep the Chromebook clean and not touch the screen with anything
- ◆ Will recharge the Chromebook battery each night.
- ◆ Will not release personal information to strangers when using the Chromebook.
- ◆ Will keep all accounts and passwords assigned to me secure and will not share these with any other students.
- ◆ Will leave the Chromebook in its protective case at all times.
- ◆ Responsible for any physical damage to the Chromebook.
- ◆ Will return the Chromebook, case, and charger when requested and upon withdrawal or graduation from the District.



# Home Considerations

Discuss the Chromebook agreement and Acceptable Use policy with your student.

Remind your student to use the device responsibly.

Set guidelines at home for when and where your student is able to use the Chromebook.

Set up a routine for charging the Chromebook and making sure that it is returned to school every day.

# **Accidents happen...**

The Long Hill Township School District is assessing an annual \$25.00 fee to protect the Chromebook against: Accidental damage (drops/spills), theft, vandalism, fire, flood, natural disasters and power surge due to lightning strikes.
