



Introducing PAC:

PAC (Parent Action Committee) is an easy way for parents to have better communication with our school leaders. LHT will pilot PAC this year.

PAC's mission is to foster supportive and positive communication to build a greater connection.

How does PAC work?

PAC will work very simply with one or two parents representing each grade. The parent representative emails all parents in their grade monthly to ask for feedback. The parents email back any compliments or concerns. Any feedback affecting more than one child is brought up at the monthly PAC meeting. Available parent reps will meet with Mr. Petrelli who will discuss our ideas with the principals at his monthly admin meeting. The grade representative then sends out the recap of the PAC meeting and any actions that have been implemented.

OK, but how does this benefit me?

Now busy parents can contribute their ideas and air their concerns at their leisure. Parents and teachers can exchange their best practices. Sharing ideas on a regular basis will improve our schools.

What about privacy?

No specific students will be discussed. Generalized concerns can address most issues (i.e. recess, amount of homework, etc.)

Does PAC need my help?

We currently have 1 representative for nearly every grade. We still need a representative for 1st and 5th grades.
