TITLE: Band Director

QUALIFICATIONS: 1) Full background in Humanities and 2) Instructional ability to teach winds and string instruments; and 3) Background to enhance Gifted and Talented children in the area of music.

REPORTS TO: Building Principal

JOB GOAL: To instruct students to learn instrumental music skills in a band and/or orchestra setting.

CERTIFICATION: Teacher of Music (Instrumental Music desired)

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provides time before or after school for orchestra and band rehearsals. (Minimum of four days per week).

Must provide extra time for grade level meetings of band, orchestra, special and ensemble groups, if necessary.

Acts as liaison between Morris-Union Consortium Band and Long Hill Township School District.

Serves as district representative relative to special state or county band activities.

Provides after-school activities for students involved in band and orchestra, including two presentations.

Responsible for Jazz Band rehearsal and performance.

All other duties or tasks assigned by the supervisor which are appropriate and applicable to the job responsibility.
