REGULATION: PARTICIPATION BY THE PUBLIC

The Long Hill Township Board of Education (BOE) believes that participation of the public in Long Hill Township School District matters is vital to a healthy school-community environment.

I. Volunteers

Each school principal shall, with the input of the teaching staff, develop procedures that govern the use of volunteers in that school building.

An active list of volunteers and their duties shall be kept by the principal.

Supervision of volunteers who work with students is expected at all times.

Volunteers who visit the school to demonstrate academically-related activities must follow regulations related to visits.

II. Advisors

Those citizens who make themselves available to serve as advisors in various aspects of curriculum development, advising, interview or ad hoc committees, etc. will have a full understanding of their tasks made clear by the appropriate administrator.

If related to school programs, the principal will maintain an updated list of participants.

If a District responsibility is being carried out, the Chief School Administrator (CSA) will maintain a list of participants.
