

REPRESENTATIVE AND DELIBERATIVE GROUPS

It shall be the philosophy of the Long Hill Township Board of Education to elicit broad-based input in the development of rules, regulations, and arrangements for the operation of the District. The Chief School Administrator (CSA), therefore, shall include wherever feasible at the planning stage, those persons who will be affected by such provisions.

The CSA shall develop channels for the timely communication of ideas and feelings regarding regarding the operation of the schools. Examples of representative groups and instruments of communication are ad hoc committees, All Schools Council, faculty, curriculum committee, or single issue meetings (citizens and staff). The CSA shall advise the Board of all such counsel in presenting reports of administrative action and in presenting recommendations to the Board for its consideration and action.
