

### NONSCHOOL EMPLOYMENT

The Long Hill Township Board of Education prohibits employees from engaging in outside activities of performing any services other than those assigned by the district while engaged in school activities.

Outside work by a staff member shall not prevent him/her from properly performing assigned functions during duty hours or be prejudicial to his/her work effectiveness.
