

CONCEPT AND ROLES IN STUDENT PERSONNEL

I. Long Hill Township Board of Education

The Long Hill Township Board of Education (BOE):

- A. Establishes District policies to provide the best attainable program of education for the District's students;
- B. Authorizes the establishment of special classes or other facilities for students who are in need of special education;
- C. Provides for the physical and mental well-being of students;
- D. Determines policies regarding student behavior and attendance within the limits of law.
- E. Approves curriculum and all test books.

II. Chief School Administrator (CSA):

The CSA:

- A. Administers all schools and classes established by the BOE;
- B. Directs the instruction, guidance and discipline of all students;
- C. Provide leadership and guidance to establish the pattern of education to be offered to students;
- D. Has general charge of the enforcement of the compulsory attendance law;
- E. Has immediate authority for the closing of schools in case of emergencies involving the health and safety of students.

III. Working Relationship Between the BOE and CSA:

Student welfare and guidance is primarily the responsibility of the CSA with the exception of the expulsion of students, which the BOE may not delegate.

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
