

PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

The Long Hill Township Board of Education (BOE) is committed to an educational program designed to enable staff members to help each individual student in his or her progress toward the goals of this district. It recognizes that parents should be continually apprised of the progress of their children in order that they may better support the work of the schools. The BOE believes that conferences between parents and teachers offer a valuable opportunity for each to share information and insights which will enhance the efforts of both to assess and meet the needs of the child.

The BOE directs the Chief School Administrator (CSA) to implement this policy by devising a program of parent-teacher conferences which shall not deny to any parent who wishes it the opportunity to confer with his/her child's teacher(s). Such a program shall include telephone and evening conferences as well as daytime conferences as the need for each may dictate.
