

RESIGNATION/REMOVAL FROM OFFICE

A member of the Long Hill Township Board of Education (BOE) believes every Board member has a responsibility to perform his/her duties to the best of his/her ability and without prejudice.

Whenever a member of the Long Hill Township BOE ceases to be a bonafide resident of the District, his/her membership shall cease immediately. The resignation of a member shall become effective immediately upon presentation of the resignation to the Board at a regular Board meeting.

Any member who fails to attend three (3) consecutive regular meetings without good cause may be removed from office on the affirmative vote of a full board majority. The action to remove said board member shall have been proposed at the preceding meeting, and notice of the action must have been given to the absent member in advance of the meeting for which such action has been proposed.

Notwithstanding the provisions of NJS 2C:51-1 or any other law to the contrary, whenever a member of the Board is disqualified as a voter pursuant to RS 19:4-1, 5 of P.L. 1987, c. 328 (18A:12-2.2) that member's membership on the Board shall immediately cease.

Any member who fails to obtain the necessary Criminal History Background Check clearance shall be removed from the Board pursuant to procedures established by the New Jersey Department of Education.
